


#### Nationally 1 in 3 Recent HS Graduates Do Not Immediately Enroll in College






#### Only about half of Michigan HS Graduates Immediately Enroll in College





#### Gaps in College Access by Subgroup




#### Declines in College-Going Outpace Declines in HS Class Size

Max decline in HS Graduation Size: 10k students (2012 to 2021)









#### Percentage of Community College Students in High School in 2022-23









#### Dual Enrollment Student Outcomes One Year After High School




## Dual Enrollment Sector Breakdown Community Colleges Four-Year Institutions New York U.S. Overall 28% 69%


#### Dual Enrollment by Gender and Neighborhood Income




#### Racial/Ethnic Representation in Dual Enrollment 2015-16 CRDC Data






#### Representation in Dual Enrollment: U.S. Public Schools

#### Major Barriers to Dual Enrollment Participation

- 1. **Policies**: Lack of funding, instructor qualifications, student eligibility
- 2. **Practices**: Lack of outreach, advising, supports
- Mindsets: Beliefs that dual enrollment is only for "advanced" students

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#### **Federal Dual Enrollment Definitions**

<u>Dual enrollment/dual credit programs</u> provide opportunities for high school students to take college-level courses offered by colleges, and earn concurrent credit toward a high school diploma and a college degree while still in high school. These programs are for high school-enrolled students who are academically prepared to enroll in college and are interested in taking on additional coursework. For example, students who want to study subjects not offered at their high school may seek supplemental education at colleges nearby. Dual enrollment/dual credit programs do not include the Advanced Placement (AP) program or the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.

#### PEDS Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System

<u>Dual Enrollment</u> refers to students who enroll in college courses offered by an institution of higher education while enrolled in high school or seeking a recognized equivalent. Student performance is recorded on a college transcript and postsecondary credit is awarded for a passing grade in the course.

- Includes: All postsecondary courses, independent of course delivery mode, course location, course instructor, whether secondary credit is also offered, and whether the student enrolls through a formal state/local program or enrolls outside a formal state/local program.
- Excludes: Credit-by-exam models such as Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate in which the student is not enrolled in a postsecondary institution.






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
IPEDS Fall Enrollments by Age – Trend Analysis




#### High School Dual Enrollment on the Rise at Our College

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


#### **Dual Credit: 1 in 4 Texas CC Student in Fall 2021**



CCRC analysis of IPEDS Fall Enrollments among students age 17 and younger at community colleges, divided by total fall enrollments.




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
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



Civil Rights Data Collection, 2017-18 School Year









# How does Florida compare to national benchmarks?



#### Dual Enrollment Student Outcomes Four Years After High School








# How do outcomes between DE and non-DE students differ in Florida? Spotlight on Hispanic students

Florida: Highest Outcomes Among DE Students Who Enrolled in College and Non-DE College Students (Ages 18–20)\*






## What bachelor's degree majors are Florida DE students completing?

Florida Students Who Completed a Bachelor's Degree Within Four Years:


Field of Study Among Dual Enrolled Completers and Completers Without Prior Dual Enrollment\*






